### Spain - Portugal

- 2018 **Cal y Canto, Bodegas Isidro Milagro** 29  
(12%) Verdejo - Viura  
*Fresh, fruity and tropical flavours well balanced*
- 2017 **Condes de Albarei, Rias Baixas** 38  
(12.5%) Albarino - **Wine Enthusiast 88**  
*It's full and plump on the palate, with standard Albariño acidity, providing energy. Nectarine and melon flavours linger on.*
- 2016 **Dominio de Tares 'La Sonrisa de Tares' Godello, Bierzo** 44  
(13%) Godello - **Decanter World Wine Awards Silver 90**  
*Honey and peach on the nose. Crisp and fresh with chalky minerality and apricot fruits. A long and lively finish*
- 2017 **Quinta de Soalheiro Alvarinho, Vinho Verde, Portugal** 48  
(12.5%) Alvarinho - **Robert Parker 92**  
*Sourced from 25-year-old vines, a big finish and a concentrated mid-palate to accompany the herbs. Ripe, fruity (V,O)*
- 2017 **Adegas Castro Brey 'Sin Palabras Castro Valdes', Rias Baixas** 49  
(12.5%) Albarino (50 year old vines) - **Penin Guide 90**  
*Expressive, white flowers, dried herbs. Fruity, balanced, good acidity, and long lingering finish (V)*

### Italy - Germany - Austria

- 2017 **Fornas Pinot Grigio delle Venezie IGT** 37  
(12.5%) Pinot Grigio  
*Abundant white summer fruits with a lovely crisp citrus acidity and a long refreshing finish (V)*
- 2017 **Domäne Wachau Terrassen Federspiel** 46  
(12.5%) Gruner Veltliner - **Wine Spectator 89**  
*Apple and dried apricot and hints of fleur de sel, firm acidity. Remains focused on the finish, ending with flinty, spicy notes*
- 2016 **Cantina Colterenzio Pinot Bianco, Alto Adige** 49  
(13%) Pinot Blanc - **James Suckling 92**  
*A fresh bouquet reminiscent of apple and pear; Crisp and zesty on the palate, round, with masses of finesse (O, V)*
- 2016 **Sartarelli Tralivio Classico Verdicchio Superiore, Marche** 49  
(13%) Verdicchio - **Decanter World Wine Awards Silver 94**  
*Fragrant nose of dried herbs, florals, ripe pears and peaches; full-bodied, juicy, crisp acidity and exceptional length (V, S)*
- 2016 **Cantine Pra 'Otto' Soave Classico, Veneto** 50  
(12.5%) Garganaga - **James Suckling 94**  
*Sliced apple and lemon as well as flint. Full body. Rich and flavorful but shows delicious acidity. (V,O)*

### New Zealand - South Africa - Argentina - Australia

- 2018 **Paddy Borthwick Sauvignon Blanc, Wairarapa NZ** 47  
(13.5%) Sauvignon Blanc - **Raymond Chan 18.5 / 20**  
*Tight and penetrating, aromatic with pungent passionfruit, tropical fruit and herb flavours on a fine-featured, linear palate.*
- 2017 **Pewsey Vale Eden Valley Riesling Australia** 55  
(11%) Riesling - **James Suckling 94**  
*Lime and lemon citrus amid stony, gently talcy minerals and hints of stone fruits. Flavors of ripe lime, apples and nectarines*
- 2017 **Rustenberg Chardonnay, Stellenbosch, SA** 55  
(13.5%) Chardonnay - **2018 Decanter World Wine Awards Silver - Decanter 94**  
*Elegant toasty French oak with lush ripe peaches and cream; rounded and complex; could easily pass as a Montagny. (V, S)*
- 2017 **Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** 59  
(13.5%) Sauvignon Blanc - **Robert Parker 90**  
*Shows hints of green on the nose but sits more firmly in the fig and stone fruit camp. It's medium-bodied, with a white grapefruit element that extends from start to finish, providing a backbone for the riper notes. Clean and refreshing (V, O)*

## France

### Bordeaux - Loire - Languedoc

- 2018 **Font-Mars Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc-Roussillon** 36  
(12.5%) Picpoul - **Decanter 92**  
*Mouthfilling, lively and long, with leesy notes helping to build and fill its character. Fresh acidity, grapefruit as well as lemon*
- 2017 **Chateau Haut Rian, Bordeaux** 37  
(12.5%) Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon - **Wine Enthusiast 88**  
*Crisp sliced-apple flavors give this wine a distinctive and delicious character. It has a touch of spice along with plenty of acidity, giving a ripe wine that has a good burst of freshness at the end (V)*
- 2017 **'Les Dissidents' Préjugés, Cabardès AOC, Languedoc-Roussillon** 38  
(13%) Chardonnay  
*Crisp focused acidity, lovely fresh citrus, mineral notes, integrated oak - what a cracker of a wine! (V)*
- 2017 **Sancerre, Dominique Roger, Domaine du Carrou, Loire** 55  
(13%) Sauvignon Blanc - **Wine Spectator 89**  
*Gooseberry, kiwifruit and lime pith notes race along together, ending with zip and clarity on the finish*
- 2016 **Chateau du Hureau, Saumur Blanc, Sec, 'Argile'** 59  
(13%) Chenin Blanc - **Decanter 89**  
*Full bodied, yet balanced by a pristine acidity, it has a fruity character with delicate white flowers (V, B)*

### Burgundy

- 2016 **Domaine Perraud, Macon-Villages, Burgundy** 53  
(13%) Chardonnay - 100% - **Decanter 90**  
*The palate is medium to full bodied, with lively citrus acidity and flavours of fruit salad including melon, peach and a hint of pineapple. The finish is minerally and long with the fresh acidity nicely balancing the full fruit (V)*
- 2017 **Domaine Gueguen Chablis** 57  
(13%) Chardonnay - **Wine Enthusiast 89**  
*This fruity vintage yields crisp-textured wines. Offering citrus and creamed-apple flavors, this wine gains further lift from its acidity and light touch of spice. It's lively, fruity and ready to drink (V, S)*
- 2016 **Château de Beauregard Macon Bussieres** 59  
(12.5%) Chardonnay  
*Because of the vineyard's altitude and limestone-rich clay, this Mâcon-Bussières shows a harmonious mineral-driven acidity. Aromatic, with notes of ripe, yellow stone fruits, this wine delivers a supple mouthfeel due to 9 months of lees aging (V)*
- 2015 **Leflaive Bourgogne** 69  
(13%) Chardonnay - **Decanter 'One of the very best Bourgogne blancs of the vintage'**  
*Very Puligny-like bouquet, intense, focussed palate of fruit and acidity (V)*
- 2015 **Chateau de Beauregard Pouilly-Fuisse Vers Cras, Maconnais** 75  
(13%) Chardonnay - **Wine Enthusiast 90**  
*Full of acidity, with a crisp edge that's a delicious part of the riper fruit. The wood-aging spiciness is well judged to give a balanced wine that is generous (V)*
- 2016 **'La Garenne' Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru, Sylvain Langoureau** 120  
(13%) Chardonnay  
*Citrus and delicately spiced pear. Medium-bodied with great balance*

### Rose

- 2017 **La Source de Château Vignelaure Rosé, Provence** 43  
(12.5%) Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault - **Wine Enthusiast 91**  
*Red-currant flavours, ripe, richly endowed and ready to drink (V)*

## **Red Wine – Spain**

- 2016 **Candidato, Cosechero Y Criadores, Bujanda Castilla La Mancha** 32  
(13%) Tempranillo  
*Aged for 3 months in American oak barrels. Notes of vanilla mocha and cream with a mineral underlay and a hint of spice.*
- 2017 **'El Castro de Valtuille' Raul Perez Castro Ventosa, Joven, Bierzo** 37  
(14%) Mencia - **Decanter 92**  
*Ripe, red-berried fruit, spice and a little pepper; palate is warming, has a dark fruit quality, reassuringly long yet elegant structure*
- 2017 **Bodegas Ponce Clos Lojen, Manchuela** 39  
(13.5%) Bobal - **Penin Guide 92**  
*Balanced aromas of ripe fruit and forest herbs, - tasty, fruity, and long (V)*
- 2016 **Abadia de Acon Joven, Ribera del Duero** 39  
(14%) Tempranillo  
*Intense and complex, a mixture of ripe red fruits. It is round, fleshy and smooth, with a clear fruity expression, elegant tannin*
- 2015 **Torre Demontalbo, Crianza, Rioja DOCa, Tempranillo** 39  
(13%) Tempranillo  
*American oak on top of ripe plum and cherry fruit, a long finish, savoury, classic*
- 2016 **Suertes del Marques 7 Fuentes, Valle de la Orotava, Canary Islands** 49  
(13%) Listan Negro, Tintilla - **Robert Parker 93**  
*The palate is really nice, electric and, has volume. This could very well be my favorite vintage of 7 Fuentes to date*
- 2011 **Alejandro Fernandez Dehesa La Granja, Castilla y León** 49  
(14%) Tempranillo - **Julian Miguel 91**  
*Complex, concentrated, filled with fruity, meaty, oaky and salty goodness. Bursting with flavors, pungently ripe and fruity (V)*
- 2012 **Alberdi Reserva, La Rioja Alta, Rioja** 55  
(13.5%) Tempranillo - **Robert Parker 90+**  
*Aging lasted two years, the first one in new American oak barrels and the second in used ones. This 2012 has some aromas of raw meat, with marked toast from the American oak with a good combination of fruit and spice, tradition and modernity*
- 2016 **Gotes, Portal del Priorat, Priorat** 59  
(14%) Garnacha, Carinena, - **WS 90**  
*Mature red fruit, wild herbs, mineral and spices. Potent delicious fruit and a touch of balsamic (V)*
- 2011 **Dominio de Tares 'Cepas Viejas' Mencia, Bierzo** 63  
(14%) Mencia - **Wine Spectator 93**  
*The plush texture delivers rich flavors of plum, blackberry and boysenberry, with accents of coffee, mountain herb, cedar and mineral. Fine-grained tannins give this structure, showing enough acidity to stay fresh. A modern-style red.*
- 2014 **Pesquera Crianza, Alejandro Fernandez, Ribera Del Duero** 68  
(14%) Tempranillo - **James Suckling 92**  
*Firm, focused, still fresh, this red delivers cherry and berry flavors accented by vanilla, spice and light herbal notes(O)*
- 2011 **Remelluri Granja Nuestra Senora de Remelluri Reserva, Rioja DOCa** 79  
(13.5%) Tempranillo, Garnacha, Graciano - **Robert Parker 92**  
*Aromas of damson plums and plenty of spices, quite ripe and heady, a little cooked. The palate is lush and round with abundant, dusty tannins. This is a powerful vintage.*
- 2015 **San Roman Bodegas y Vinedos 'San Roman', Toro** 89  
(14.5%) Tempranillo - **Decanter 95**  
*Chocolate from the oak, cherry & elderberry, tobacco smoke & cedar. Silky texture. Great persistence, power and elegance*
- 2009 **La Rioja Alta 'Gran Reserva 904', Rioja** 109  
(12.5%) Tempranillo - **Robert Parker 95+**  
*The palate is polished but has some clout, with clean, focused flavors and a long, spicy and tasty finish.*
- 2011 **Emilio Moro 'Malleolus de Sanchomartin', Ribera del Duero** 199  
(14.5%) Tempranillo - **'The best wine in the Ribero de Duero' - Wine Spectator 94**  
*This powerful red has a plush, mouth filling texture, well-integrated tannins. The flavors are complex and harmonious, with plum, cocoa, loamy earth, mineral and baking spice elements. Bold but balanced, in the modern style*

## France

### Bordeaux

- 2009 **Albert Schweitzer Chateau Les Violettes, Cotes de Bordeaux Blaye** 45  
(13%) Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon - **Gilbert & Gaillard 88**  
*Feminine, fine texture, soft matter, melted tannins. The fruit does not miss the opportunity to reign. Pleasantly mature*
- 2016 **Chateau Peyredon Lagravette, Listrac-Medoc** 59  
(13.5%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot - **Robert Parker 90**  
*A crisp and discretely intense bouquet with scents of gravel and black fruit, medium-bodied with fine tannin, very classic*
- 2009 **Chateau Franc Patarabet, St Emilion Grand Cru** 69  
(13%) Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon - **Concours des Feminalise Silver Medal**  
*Cherry and vanilla aromas. Well balanced with intense fruit and smooth tannins*
- 2011 **Chateau Gaudin, Pauillac** 85  
(13%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc - **Wine Enthusiast 92**  
*Plump, velvety dark fruits with spicy undertones. A beautiful structure and soft tannins*
- 2015 **Château le Puy 'Emilien' Francs Côtes de Bordeaux** 89  
(12%) Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carménère - **Decanter 94**  
*Beautifully plump ripe fruit, practically bursting out of the glass but with excellent tension and balance. Utterly delicious(B)*
- 2012 **Chateau Labegorce, Margaux** 99  
(13.5%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc - **Wine Enthusiast 90**  
*Spice and cedar, blackcurrant fruit. Smooth and juicy, Margaux perfume adorning the finish*
- 2010 **Chateau Petit Village, Pomerol** 149  
(13%) Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon - **Tim Atkin 94**  
*Warm generous style with plummy fruit. Polished, good depth and round, ripe style. This is always a well made Pomerol that is consistent year after year but in 2010 it shines. Good length*
- 2010 **Chateau Roc de Cambes, Cotes de Bourg** 169  
(14%) Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc - **Decanter 94**  
*An atypical savoury character, yet it's complex and vibrant. The palate is immensely concentrated, with firm tannins that aren't too grippy, and a remarkable bite and tension. Assertive and dazzling.*
- 2010 **Chateau Talbot, Saint-Julien, 4ème Cru Classé** 199  
(13%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot - **Tim Atkin 94**  
*The deep ruby 2010 edition has aromas of cedar, plums and blackberries, supported by good precision and balance of soft fruit flavours and supple, delicate tannins. This is a very elegant, medium bodied Talbot*
- 2010 **Chateau Grand-Puy-Lacoste, Pauillac, 5ème Cru Classé** 299  
(13.5%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot - **Robert Parker 95**  
*An absolutely magnificent wine from this very popular estate, its classic creme de cassis and floral notes are well-displayed. The wine possesses supple tannin, a full body, voluptuous character and a layered, impressively textured mouthfeel. This is a brilliant effort from Grand Puy Lacoste*
- 2010 **Domaine de Chevalier, Pessac-Leognan** 325  
(13.5%) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdo - **Robert Parker 95**  
*This is one of my all-time favorite wines from Domaine de Chevalier, a silky, rather classic Pessac-Leognan with notes of scorched earth, tobacco leaf and black and red currants, but no hard edges. Fragrant, complex aromatics are followed by a savory, expansively flavored wine. An opulent, precocious style of wine that seems much more developed, complex and delicious than I thought from barrel - a beauty.*

### Beaujolais

- 2015 **Stephane Aviron Domaine de la Madriere Fleurie Vieilles Vignes, Beaujolais** 49  
(13%) Gamay - **Wine Enthusiast 91**  
*Packed with cheerful red fruits that are given a more serious edge by the tannic structure and acidity, with a touch of pepper and minerality*
- 2014 **Louis Jadot Chateau des Jacques Morgon, Beaujolais** 49  
(13.5%) Gamay - **Robert Parker 89**  
*Sweetness of oak on the nose. Tight, juicy, firm and finely textured. Beautifully balanced and persistent.*

## Burgundy

- 2016 **Jean-Claude Regnaudot et Fils, Bourgogne** 59  
(12.5%) Pinot Noir - **Tim Atkin 90**  
*Intense and juicy flavours of black cherries and red berries(V)*
- 2016 **Maison Bertrand Ambroise, Côte de Nuits Villages** 75  
(13%) Pinot Noir - **Tim Aiken 89**  
*Black cherry with vanilla. A little chewiness that opens up with air (O, V)*
- 2011 **Louis Jadot Les Rugiens, Pommard Premier Cru, Beaune** 140  
(13.5%) Pinot Noir - **Wine Spectator 91**  
*Spice and structure a rich, supple red. The cherry and berry notes hold the middle ground. An elegant red, juicy and long*
- 2014 **Benjamin Leroux, Vosne-Romanee** 150  
(13%) Pinot Noir - **Tim Atkin 92**  
*Sleek, delicious and seductively textured medium weight flavors, very fine depth, long and well-balanced*

## Rhone

- 2016 **Domaine de la Renjarde, Cotes du Rhone Villages les Cassagnes de la Nerthe** 54  
(14%) Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre - **Robert Parker 91**  
*Plush, velvety, fruit-forward, a medium to full-bodied beauty. Tons of almond-tinged cherries, ample concentration and waves of supple tannins. The fruit here is compelling*
- 2015 **Domaine de la Charbonniere, Vacqueyras** 58  
(15%) Grenache, Syrah - **Robert Parker 91**  
*Combines lovely ripe cherries with tarry, plummy notes. It's medium to full-bodied, with a long, supple finish appellation (O)*
- 2015 **Crozes-Hermitage Domaine des Remizières Cuvée Particulière** 59  
(13%) Syrah - **Robert Parker 91**  
*Blackcurrants, blueberries, crushed rocks and peppery herbs all give way to a medium to full-bodied, beautifully pure, polished and elegant Syrah that has tons to love*
- 2015 **Chateau La Nerthe, Chateauneuf-du-Pape** 79  
(14%) Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault - **Robert Parker 92**  
*Overlay of exotic toasted coconut and vanilla aromas and flavors. Beyond that, there's ample weight, hints of cinnamon and clove and cherry fruit that lingers on the silky finish (O)*
- 2015 **Domaine du Vieux Telegraphe Chateauneuf-du-Pape La Crau** 115  
(14.5%) Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault - **Jeff Leve 94**  
*Silky, ripe, sweet and fresh, the wine offers a classic, elegant profile of Grenache, with a focus on its ripe, sweet, cherry core. Soft polished, long, fresh and pure, the wine is not about power - an elegant, fresh sweet expression of fruit (O)*
- 2012 **Domaine Jean-Michel Gerin Cote Rotie Champin le Seigneur** 130  
(13%) Syrah, Viognier - **Wine Spectator 93**  
*Tightly coiled, with a pleasant iron spine, this has a reserve of red currant, damson plum and raspberry fruit waiting to unfurl. Lifting bergamot and singed alder hints line the finish, revealing a latent richness*

## Languedoc - Southwest

- 2017 **Marius by Michel Chapoutier, IGP Pays d'Oc** 36  
(13.5%) Grenache Syrah - **Robert Parker 90**  
*Tons of peppery herbs, currants, blackberry fruits, medium body, more purity and length than you'd expect at the price*
- 2016 **Chateau de Gaudou Tradition, Cahors** 39  
(13.5%) Malbec, Merlot, Tannat - **Decanter 94**  
*Black fruit notes and jammy, chalky, woody, discreet. Fleshy, delicious, solid structure. Good traditional wine (V)*
- 2017 **Les Argelieres Languedoc Pinot Noir Grande Cuvee** 42  
(13%) Pinot Noir  
*Lovely aromas of raspberry and cherry, subtle smoky, and peppery hints with notes of thyme. Fruity, elegant, well balanced*

## Italy

- 2017 **Feudi del Pisciotto Baglio del Sole Nero d'Avola, Sicily** 38  
(13.%) Nero d'Avola - **James Suckling - 90**  
*Black cherries and blackberry, full bodied, slightly spicy with soft tannins.*
- 2016 **Pico Maccario Lavignone Barbera D'Asti, Piedmont** 49  
(13.5%) Barbera - **Wine Spectator 90**  
*Aromas of cherry, plum and red berries The wine's earthy flavours give way to blackberry, pomegranate and fruitcake flavours. Ends with a beam of pure blackberry*
- 2016 **Poggio Bonelli Chianti Classico DOCG** 53  
(13.5%) Sangiovese, Merlot - **Wine Spectator 95**  
*Stylish and contemporary wine with dark concentration and broad appeal. It delivers its intensity with force across the board with a lasting and generous disposition. Aromas of dark cherry and prune with spice, tobacco and Spanish cedar*
- 2015 **'Ornello' Rocca di Frassinello Maremma Toscana, Tuscany** 55  
(14%) Sangiovese, Syrah, Merlot - **Robert Parker 90**  
*A rich style. Cherry, plum, leather, earth and spice flavours, with lively acidity (O)*
- 2017 **Tenuta delle Terre Nere Rosso Etna, Sicily** 59  
(13.5%) Nerello Cappuccio, Nerello Mascalese - **Wine Enthusiast 93**
